PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

Greetings

Thank you for remembering the date – June 10, 2023! Our golf fundraising event was a great success!

There were total of 54 golf players, of these, seven were Baylor Vets. Overall funding results- 32 members donated a total of \$14,150 in cash donations and \$3,875 in player fees. Nine businesses and ten non-members donated \$5,820 and various donation-in-kinds have been received from multiple businesses and individuals.

Our scholarship committee reviewed 30 applications and selected nine of those for interviews on June 29th and July 6^{th.} Of the nine, five are high school applicants and four were Baylor students. Scholarship awardees will be announced at our July membership luncheon.

Last month, our Board of Directors voted to increase the scholarship budget from up to \$13,000 to \$15,000 due to the large number of applicants and potential awardees.

Our scholarship and grant programs help prepare those who will lead in the future. Our donations to local and national veteran support organizations will assist those who are serving, have honorably served our nation and their dependents. This shows our commitment to Chapter/Foundation 2023 goals and objectives and lays our course to becoming a premier veteran's support organization in Central Texas.

We are starting planning for our June 8, 2024 fundraiser with the goal of achieving continued membership support and increasing Waco community involvement in the event.

Our Board Nominating Committee has begun the selection process to replace Board Directors whose terms of service will expire at the end of this year. I encourage those interested serving on our Board of Directors to contact Bill Milnor. New Board

members are needed to bring fresh and innovative ideas to keep our organization dynamic and viable.

FOURTH ON THE BRAZOS

The City of Waco will have their annual Fourth on the Brazos celebration, featuring the H-E-B Fireworks Extravaganza and live music.

Fourth on the Brazos will be featured at Touchdown Alley (next to McLane Stadium). It is a Waco tradition with food trucks, live entertainment, family fund and fireworks. **Admission is free**. Gates open at 6 p.m. and the fireworks kick off at 9:15 p.m. There will be a patriotic ceremony by the Waco Community Band prior to fireworks starting.

There is a clear bag/purse policy to enter Touchdown Alley area. This is required for security reasons and to facilitate entry on security checks.

MEMBER SPOTLIGHT – GARY J URBAN, PAST PRESIDENT, HOT CHAPTER, MOAA



In his distinguished United States Air Force (USAF) career, Gary Urban served as both a Senior Non-Commissioned and Commissioned Officer. During his 25 year career, he held positions

that included Missile Crew Commander, Forward Air Control Intelligence Observer, Safety Officer, Command Post Controller, Operations and Resource Management Officer, and Chief of Base Intelligence. Gary served two tours in Viet Nam and held posts in Alaska, Nebraska, California, Texas, and Arkansas. Gary retired from active duty as a Major.

He was an Honor Graduate U.S. Air Force Alaskan Air Command Non-Commissioned Officers Academy, Distinguished Graduate of the U.S. Air Force Officer Training School, and graduate of the USAF Squadron Officers School. Gary has a Masters of Arts in Public Administration from Weber State University; a Bachelors of Arts in General Studies in Geomorphology/Geography/History from the University of Nebraska, Omaha; Associates in Risk Management for the Insurance Institute of America; and is a Texas Licensed Risk Manager.

After the Air Force, Gary held several positions with the city of San Antonio. From August 1992 to April 1996, he served as San Antonio's Safety Training Officer and Safety Program Supervisor where he developed a variety of safety training plans and managed the safety inspection and training programs for over 11,500 city employees. Gary assumed more responsibilities as the Special Projects Coordinator, Risk Management Division, City of San Antonio, where he developed and monitored a \$22,000,000 annual budget for self-insured workers compensation, liability and safety programs,

In 2002, Gary began his career with the City of Waco as Director of Risk Management where he was responsible for managing a \$4,200,000 risk management budget and protecting \$238,900,000 in municipal assets. By employing Risk Management techniques, he reduced the annual budget to less than \$3,000,000. In 2009, he became Director of General Services Department when General

Services (Fleet Services, Purchasing, & Facilities) was combined with Risk Management, Safety, and Employee Health Services. Gary was responsible for a workforce of 80 professional and technical employees.

Gary has spent several years volunteering and serving in veteran and public service roles - to name a few - Volunteer and PEER facilitator for the Waco Veterans One-Stop since 2005; Vice President of the Heart of Texas Vietnam Veterans of America Association. Past President and Board of Director's member of the State of Texas Public Risk Management Association, HOT MOAA Past President and member Board of Directors.

In 2016, Gary Received the Congressional Veterans Commendation from U.S. Congressman Bill Flores, Texas – 17 for service in the U.S. Air Force and service to the community in support of numerous veteran assistance programs

Gary is married to his wife Antoinette of 53 years and has two children and one grandchild.
